**RULES**

1. Judging will begin at 8:00 a.m., Saturday, October 4, 2008. Coaches and Members will meet at the George Barn Show Arena bleachers at 7:00 a.m. **Contestants must stay in the bleacher area until instructions are given by the Chairman.**
2. Any FFA Chapter or 4-H Club may enter. All teams will consist of three (3) members. Chapters and clubs may enter individuals also.
3. The number of Junior or Senior teams and Junior or Senior individuals entering the Livestock Judging Contest will not be limited.
4. Entry fee of **\$18.00** per team or **\$6.00** per individual will be charged.
5. Junior team members or individuals must be in the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Senior team members or individuals must be in the 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Junior or Senior division must be indicated on the entry form. If a team, team member, or individual is entered in the wrong age division, the team will be automatically disqualified. In the individual contest the individual will be automatically disqualified.
6. Scan sheets will be used and provided by Fort Bend County Fair and all scores will be tabulated by computer. Each contestant will be provided with one scan sheet. Replacement scan sheets will cost \$1.00 per sheet. No scan sheets will be replaced after the contest begins.
7. Contestants should bring #2 pencils and a manila folder to protect their scan sheet from dirt and moisture.
8. All contestants will be required to correctly fill in their name, team name, team number, and placings. All ovals must be colored in completely and must be dark.
9. The following are possible classes to be judged:
  - a. Two classes of Market Steers
  - b. Two classes to be determined date of judging
  - c. Two classes of Market Lambs
  - d. One class of Barrow
  - e. One class of Breeding Gilts
  - f. One class of Market Goats
10. Each class will consist of four (4) animals.
11. Each contestant will be allowed 10 minutes per class.

12. JUNIOR AND SENIOR DIVISION AWARDS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

**OPEN YOUTH**

TEAM

Plaques will be given to the top 3 teams (3 per team) in both the Junior and Senior Divisions.

INDIVIDUAL

Junior High Individuals – 1<sup>st</sup> receives belt buckle; 2<sup>nd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> receive embroidered barrel bag.

Senior High Individuals – 1<sup>st</sup> receives belt buckle; 2<sup>nd</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> receive embroidered barrel bag.

INDIVIDUAL

Junior High Individuals – 1<sup>st</sup> receives belt buckle; 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> receive embroidered garment bag.

Senior High Individuals – 1<sup>st</sup> receives belt buckle; 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> receive embroidered garment bag.

13. Awards will be given at approximately 12:30 p.m. Please be present.
